COACH PADOVAN



RAY PADOVAN

Head Coach ... Dean of Coaches at EIU
... 42nd Year as Men's Head Coach
... 29th Year as Women's Head Coach

Ray Padovan, the dean of EIU coaches and a former NCAA record-holder, enters his final season as skipper of the Panther swimming and diving teams. This season will be his 42nd year coaching the men's program and 29th year overseeing the women's program.

During his tenure, he has coached the men to seven conference championships, including victories at the Midwest Championships in 2004 and 2005, an undefeated (12-0) season in 2002, and earning over 250 dual meet victories (252-187-1 overall).

On the women's side, he has a 164-129 dual meet record and a 2003 Midwest Championship championship under his belt.

Padovan earned three consecutive 'Coach of the Meet' awards during the last three years the Panthers competed as an independent squad while taking part in the Midwest Championships, earning the honor as women's coach in 2003 and the men's honor in both 2004 and 2005.

Prior to the 2005-06 season, the Panthers returned as an associate member of the Mid-Continent Conference after competing previously for sixteen seasons as a member of the Mid-Con. EIU competed independently from 1997-2005. The name of the Mid-Con has since gone through a name change to now be known as the Summit League over the summer of 2007.

At last season's Mid-Con Championship both Panther squads finished in third place, while five men and one women earned all-conference honors.

Prior to competing at the NCAA Division I level, Padovan was named the 1981 NCAA Division II National 'Coach of the Year' after directing the Panthers to a sixth place national finish in Eastern's last year at that level. In 14 years of NAIA or NCAA Division II competition, he has coached the men to nine top 10 finishes, with 24 swimmers earning 124 total All-American honors.

In three years of competition at the Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (AIAW) Division II national meet, Padovan led the women to 25th, 12th and 15th place between 1981-83. Nine Panther women earned 32 All-American honors.

A member of the Southern Illinois University 'Hall of Fame', Padovan set NCAA records in the 50 and 100-freestyles back in 1961 while earning his undergraduate degree in physical education in 1964 and a master's degree in health in 1965.

He coached one year at Eastern New Mexico where the Greyhounds were second at the NAIA National Tournament.

A native of North Miami, Florida, Padovan competed at the Masters Championships in 1986 where he set five national 45-49 age group records.

Padovan recently retired from being an assistant professor in the EIU College of Education and Professional Studies.

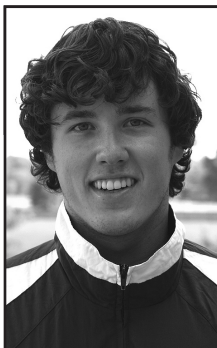
JASON MAURER

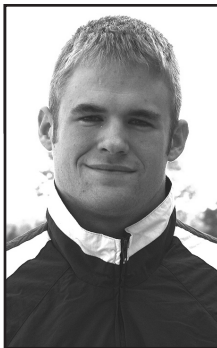


BRENT NOBLE

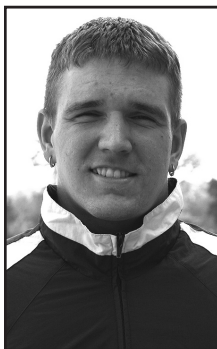

THE SUMMIT LEAGUE

Prior to the 2005-06 athletic season, both the Eastern Illinois University swimming squads re-joined the Mid-Continent Conference as an associate member, after previous membership in the league between the 1979-1996 seasons.

Over the summer of 2007, the Mid-Con league name was changed to The Summit League.

"It is good to to be back in this league," EIU head coach Ray Padovan said. "Through the years we have established some very competitive rivalries with many current conference teams, having competed against them in past dual and/or tournament action."

The Summit League is comprised of nine member institutions: Centenary College of Louisiana, Chicago State, Indiana-Purdue at Indianapolis, Missouri-Kansas City, Oakland University, Oral Roberts, Southern Utah, Valparaiso and Western Illinois. Besides EIU, South Dakota State is also an associate Summit League member.

During the 1997-2005 season, Eastern Illinois competed as an independent squad and participated at the Midwest Classic Championship at the end of each year. Besides the two swimming programs, the EIU Panther men's soccer squad is also an affiliate member of a midwest-based conference, having joined the Missouri Valley Conference back in 1996.

The 2007-08 Summit League Championship will be hosted by league foe Oakland University up north in Rochester, Michigan on February 21-23.

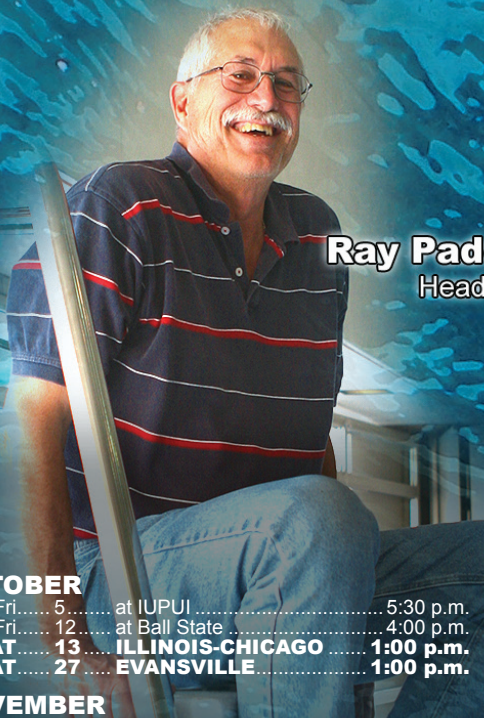
